Treats

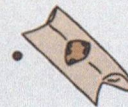
How to:

THE THREE-CUP GAME

What you'll need:

Three paper cups
Some treats

How to:

This is a great game for dogs who like to follow their nose and have experience with scent work. Line up three paper cups and start by putting a treat under one of the cups while your dog watches.

Give them the ok to show you which one is the right cup and let them have the treat when they choose correctly. Once they get the hang of it, you can make it more challenging by mixing up the cups after you place the treat.

What you'll need:

Your dog
A lead and harness
An adventurous spirit!

How to:

Take your dog for a walk to a new dog-friendly area you haven't been before, and let their nose lead the way!

A 'sniffari' is all about allowing your dog to meander at their own pace and follow their nose! They can explore new smells while getting physical exercise and mental stimulation.

SNUFFLE MAT

What you'll need:

- Thin fleece sheets, blankets or offcuts - in as many colours as you like
- A rubber mat with holes (from hardware store) roughly 40cm x 60cm
- Scissors
- A ruler

How to:

Cut the fleece into strips 5cm wide and 30cm long. They can be different lengths for fun!

Thread the strips through the bottom of two holes in the same row so the ends are pointing up. Secure the material by tying a single knot. Continue along all the rows, once finished go back and tie some knots diagonally in each direction to fill any gaps.

Hide some treats amongst the fleece and let your dog sniff them out!
